

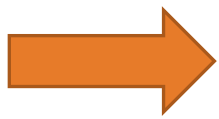

Users should be able to quickly delete all 'inactive' saved searches

Larger organisations have created literally tens of thousands of pointer files in Adlib, and there is no reason to think that Collections users will do any differently. This has forced us to build filtering options, spend time increasing performance of the Saved Search dialogue, etc. This is clearly a problem for medium to large-sized organisations.

The problem is that it users very rarely, if ever, decide 'I am done with this Saved Search, so I should delete it'. It's hard to say you will be done with something, and even if you have affirmatively decided that, you need to do work to delete the Saved Search. It's even more work for an admin to delete inactive Searches, because it is hard to tell if a Saved Search is in active use. So the tendency is for them to continue to build and build, and there is no pressure pushing their number down.

I would suggest tracking 'last retrieved'. Created and modified are not helpful, as a Saved Search can be useful for years without any changes to the records it retrieves. But if a retrieval date is tracked, it is much easier for Admins to identify all Saved Searches that no one has used for the past [insert period]. At that point, there could be a 'Mark all/Delete' option, or perhaps an automated process that every month deletes all Saved Searches that haven't been used for a year.
